The papers of Frederic Sterling Lee, former Professor of Economics at the University of Missouri-Kansas City, contain his personal and professional research files, correspondence, writings and edited works. Dr. Lee was internationally known for his work on alternative microeconomic theory.

#### BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Frederic S. Lee received his PhD in economics from Rutgers University in 1983. His teaching career includes being a lecturer at the University of California-Riverside, 1981-1984; Assistant/Associate professor at Roosevelt University (Chicago), 1984-1991; Reader in Economics at De Montfort University (UK), 1991-2000; and Professor of Economics at the University of Missouri-Kansas City, 2000 to present.

Lee established the Association for Heterodox Economics (UK) in 1999 which continues today. He organized Post Keynesian Economics Study (UK) seminars in 1998-2000. From 2003 until 2009, Lee was editor of the book series Advances in Heterodox Economics with University of Michigan Press and later with Routledge. In 2004, he established the Heterodox Economics Newsletter and remained the editor until 2009. Lee also was the editor of the American Journal of Economics and Sociology from 2009-2013. From 2006-2010 Lee was the Executive Director of the International Confederation of Associations for Pluralism in Economics; President of the Association for Institutional Thought (2011-2012); and President-elect of the Association for Evolutionary Economics (2014).

Frederic S. Lee was born on November 24, 1949 in Nyack, New York. He died October 23, 2014 in Webster Groves, Missouri.
